Japanese Knotweed (*Fallopia japonica*)
Giant Knotweed (*Fallopia sachalinensis*)
Bohemian Knotweed (*Fallopia x bohemica*)

Do you have knotweed in your YARD WASTE?

If so, please notify the **Site Operator** so that all plant parts (leaves, stems, roots) are appropriately disposed of in **Mixed Waste Bin** - at no extra charge.

Invasive knotweeds cause significant damage.

Invasive knotweeds grow forcefully through asphalt, building foundations, concrete retaining walls and even drains. They crowd out native plants and cause a decline in biodiversity.
