Aquatic invasive species can have negative impacts on the environment, economy, and public health. They can damage local fisheries, increase taxes, and cause health problems.



CLEAN off all plants, animals, and mud from watercraft and related equipment (e.g. waders, fishing gear, life jackets)



DRAIN onto dry land any item that can hold water (e.g. bilge, ballast, wells, buckets)



DRY all items completely before launching the watercraft into another body of water

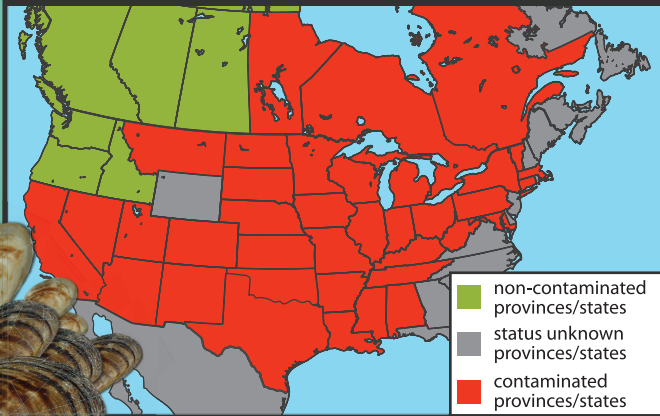


IF YES, then your watercraft might be transporting invasive zebra or quagga mussels. Help protect BC waters from these devastating aquatic invasive species.
