

CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is the Central Kootenay Invasive Species Society, hereafter referred to as the “Committee”.
2. The purposes of the Society are, within the geographic area of the Regional District of the Central Kootenay and Areas A & B of the Regional District of the Kootenay Boundary:
 - a) To raise awareness and educate the public, government agencies, and other land managers about invasive species and their impacts in the area;
 - b) To prevent the further introduction OR and spread of invasive species in the area through education and awareness, early detection and control, and coordinated integrated weed management efforts;
 - c) To promote coordinated and collaborative management of invasive species between agencies and land occupiers;
 - d) To work towards the control/containment of highly invasive non-native species;
 - e) To provide a conduit for information and a source of expertise on invasive species;
 - f) To develop and maintain a comprehensive inventory of invasive species within the area of responsibility.
