2	Eradication/Annual Control	Species with limited distribution and low density on infested sites. Species invading susceptible habitats, sensitive areas, or sites containing red- or blue-listed species. New infestations of established species in the area beyond the original population.	Eradication or annual control is the main management focus - check IAPP for known sites and report new locations.
3	Containment	Established infestations in waterways. These species are well established in some parts of the CKISS Region but have not yet infested all potential habitats.	Control and containment are the main management focus - report sightings in areas outside known distribution - prevent spread outside these locations.
4	Established; Strategic Management	Established throughout CKISS Region.	Prevention of spread is the main management focus.
